### INSTRUCTIONS

Read Carefully and Comply Fully

This form shall be filed in triplicate with the State Oil and Gas Board at the address below covering each well or wells from which oil, gas, or condensate is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil, gas, or condensate from a well.

If, oil, gas, or condensate is being transported from multiple wells, and there is a common transporter and a common purchaser for each of the wells, then an operator may submit a single Operator's Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil, Gas, or Condensate from Well, Form OGB-12, listing the permit number, well name and number, and field name for each well.

After said certificate has been approved by the State Oil and Gas Board, one copy will be forwarded to the transporter; one copy returned to the producer; and one copy retained by the Board.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in the transporter. In the case of a TEMPORARY CHANGE in the transporter involving less than the allowable production for one month, written notice shall be furnished the State Oil and Gas Board by the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Board. The letter shall state the estimated amount of oil, gas, or condensate to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil, gas, or condensate from the well and the name of such temporary transporter. A copy of the written notice shall be furnished to the temporary transporter, who shall not move any more oil, gas, or condensate than the estimated amount shown in the notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the State Oil and Gas Board shall constitute an authorization to a pipeline or other carrier to transport oil, gas, or condensate from the well(s) named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

1. Operating ownership changes; or
2. The transporter is changed; or
3. The authorization is canceled by the State Oil and Gas Board.

In all cases where the certificate is filed to cover a change in operating ownership or a change in the transporter designated to move oil, gas, or condensate, show under "REMARKS" the previous owner or operator and the transporter previously authorized to transport oil, gas or condensate.

Make sure that you complete the form correctly and provide all the information requested. **State Oil and Gas Board personnel will not make additions to or change any part of a notarized form.**
